19TH ADVENTURE CHALLENGE FOR SCHOOLSTM 2016

From 5th to 9th December 2016, Stanford Lake College once again hosted the annual Adventure Challenge for SchoolsTM. The event consisted of many disciplines, including rafting, mountain biking, trail running, swimming, obstacles, first aid, rope traverse and structure building to name a few. Teams from Zimbabwe, Zambia, and South Africa went head to head over the 4 days and raced over 200 km! This took place around Magoebaskloof and also two days in the Soutpansberg near Louis Trichardt.

The teams competed in a series of high adrenaline events which covered night rafting, paddling and portaging, navigation and problem solving.
